Debit/Credit Cards	<p><i>Preauthorization is a process where a certain amount of money is temporarily held from your credit or debit card to ensure that funds are available for your move 🏠🔒.</i></p> <p>Shortly before the move is complete, the final cost is adjusted based on actual time and services provided. Think of preauthorization as a friendly handshake between your bank and Move Central. It's our way of saying, "Hey, we're about to do some heavy lifting here, can you spot us the funds?" 🤝🏠🚚</p>

It's essentially the remaining amount due after the deposit has been deducted.</i></p> <p>By offering a variety of payment options, we ensure that the payment process is as smooth as your move. It's out way of making sure that the only "change" you must worry about is your new address, not the jingling coins in your pocket! 🏠👛</p>
